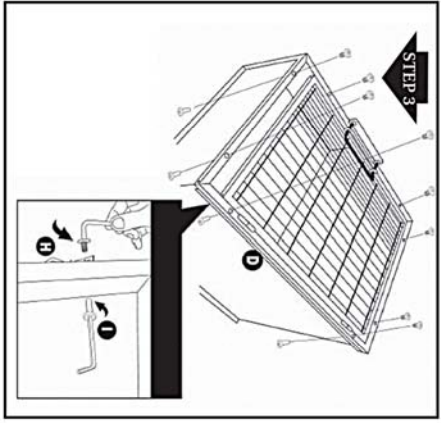
TIP: For each step, do not completely tighten screws and bolts until all have been fitted to the structure.



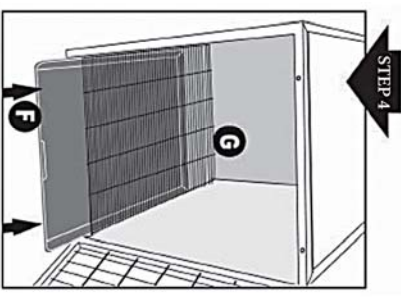
1. Connect Side Panels (A) to Top and Bottom Panels (C) using Screws (J). Note: the panel sides with the metal edging should all be facing out. The flat sides should face in.



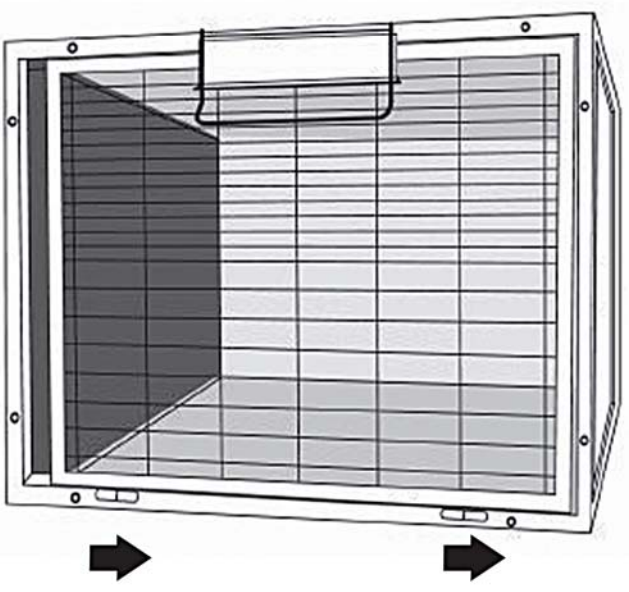
2. Connect the Back Panel (B) to the assembled panels using Screws (J).



3. Attach the Front Panel (D) to the front of the structure using Bolts (H and I). The smaller (H) bolts should connect from the front, the Larger (I) bolts should connect from the back. Use the two Allen Wrenches (E) as shown to secure bolts during assembly.



4. Slide the Floor Tray (F) and the Floor Grate (G) into the structure.



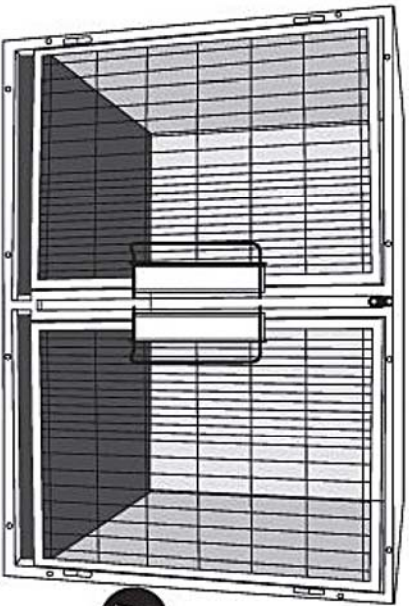
5. The doors can be taken off the hinges by lifting them straight up and off.

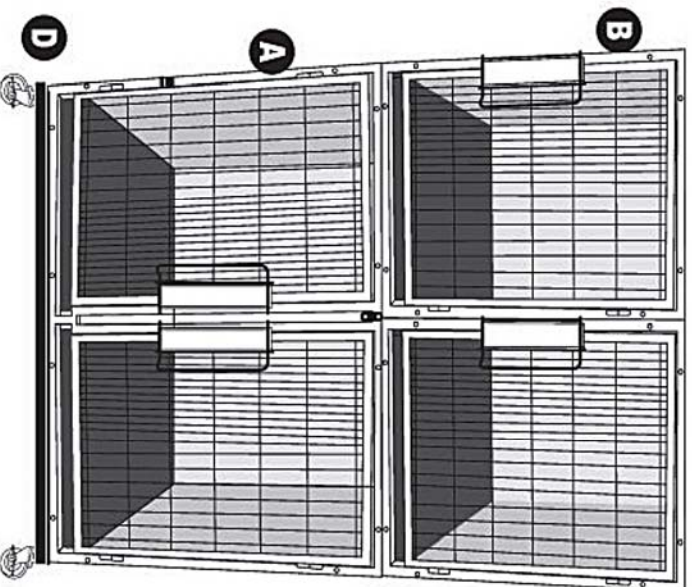


Arrange the two Medium Cages on top of the one Large Cage. Not sold with Cage Base.

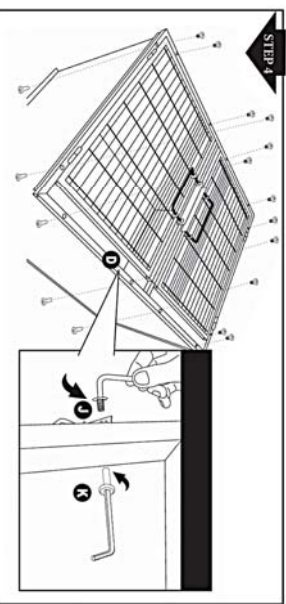
1. Connect the Side Panels (A) to the Top and Bottom Panels (C) using Screws (L). Note: the panel sides with the metal edging should all be facing out. The flat sides should face in.



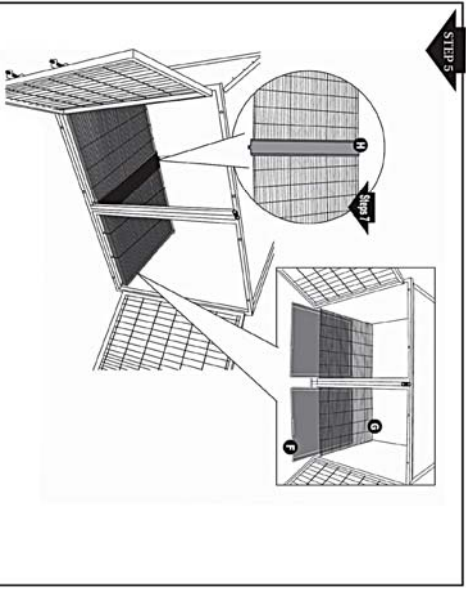
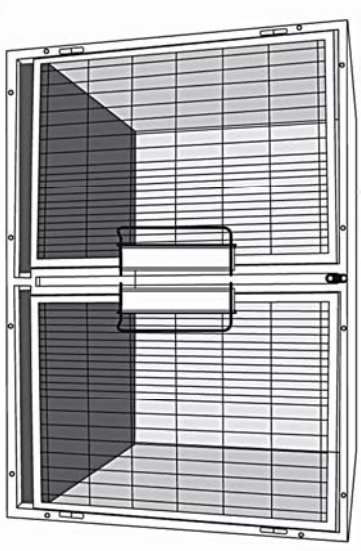
2. Connect the Dividing Panel Holder (I) to the Back Panel (B) using Screws (L). Note: The end where the Dividing Panel Holder (I) is closer to the edge of the Back Panel is the bottom end.



3. Connect the Back Panel (B) to the assembled panels using Screws (L).



4. Secure the Front Panel (D) to the assembled panels using bolts J and K. The smaller (J) bolts should connect from the front, the Larger (K) bolts from the back. Use the two Allen Wrenches (E) secure the bolts as shown.



5. Slide the two Floor Grates (F) and Floor Grates (G) into the cage. Place the Floor Grate Connection Panel (H) over the gap between the two Grates. To remove Floor Grates from this cage, lift the Grate up and turn it at an angle. The Grate will slide right out.

7. The doors can be taken off the hinges of the Front Panel by lifting them straight up and off.

8. An optional Divider Panel (sold separately) can be used to separate this large cage into two smaller ones. See PetEdge.com for details.
